



MIKE MUELLER CHARITIES OFFICIALLY PRESENT AMBULANCE TO JFK

Mike Mueller Charities, an intentionally astute humanitarian and philanthropic institution, Friday officially presented an emergency response units ambulance to authorities at the John F. Kennedy Memorial Hospital.

The John F. Kennedy Memorial Hospital, situated in Sinkor, Monrovia, is the largest public referral hospital in the country. The hospital is named in honor of the late United States President, John F. Kennedy.

The Mike Mueller Charities was established by Liberians in the Diaspora in collaboration with the European Federation of Liberian Associations (“EFLA”), Coalition of Concerned Liberians, U.S.A. (“CAL”) and the support of friends of Liberia within the international community. Presenting the ambulance on behalf of his entity, Mike Mueller Charities to authorities of the JFK Hospital, Mr. Mike Mueller said the presentation marks the beginning of more donations to the hospital.

“We assure you that with efficient management, this gesture today will signal only the beginning of much more to come,” the humanitarian said. Mr. Mueller then called on authorities of the Hospital (JFK) to utilize the gesture with great stewardship in saving lives. “I commend you on your continuing sacrifice in the field of saving lives. We trust that this gift given to you this day will be utilized with great stewardship,” Mueller added.

For her part,, the Acting Chief Medical Officer of the JFK, Madam Ayele Cox, expressed gratitude to Mike Mueller Charities for the gesture and promised to use the ambulance to reach out to the needy.

The JFK Hospital, according to Madam Cox, has been without an ambulance for a long time; noting, “This ambulance will help reduce some of our capacity constraints.

The presentation ceremony, held on the premises of the JFK Hospital, was attend by several medical practitioners, lawmakers, friends of the Mike Mueller Charities and other well wishers.
